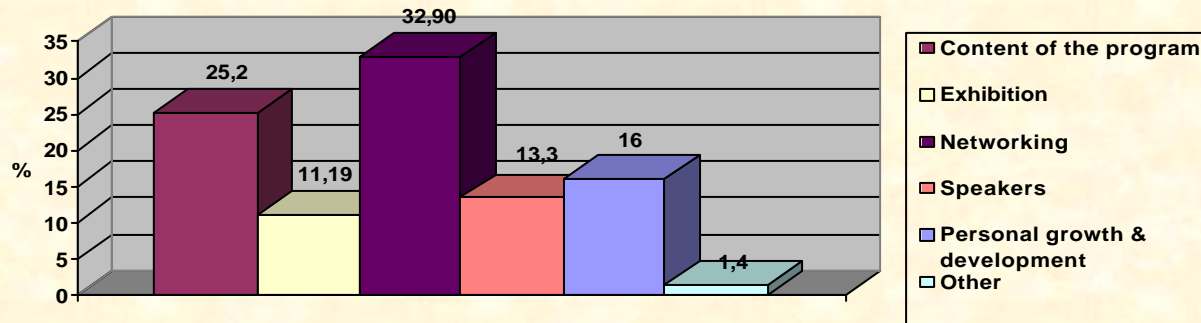

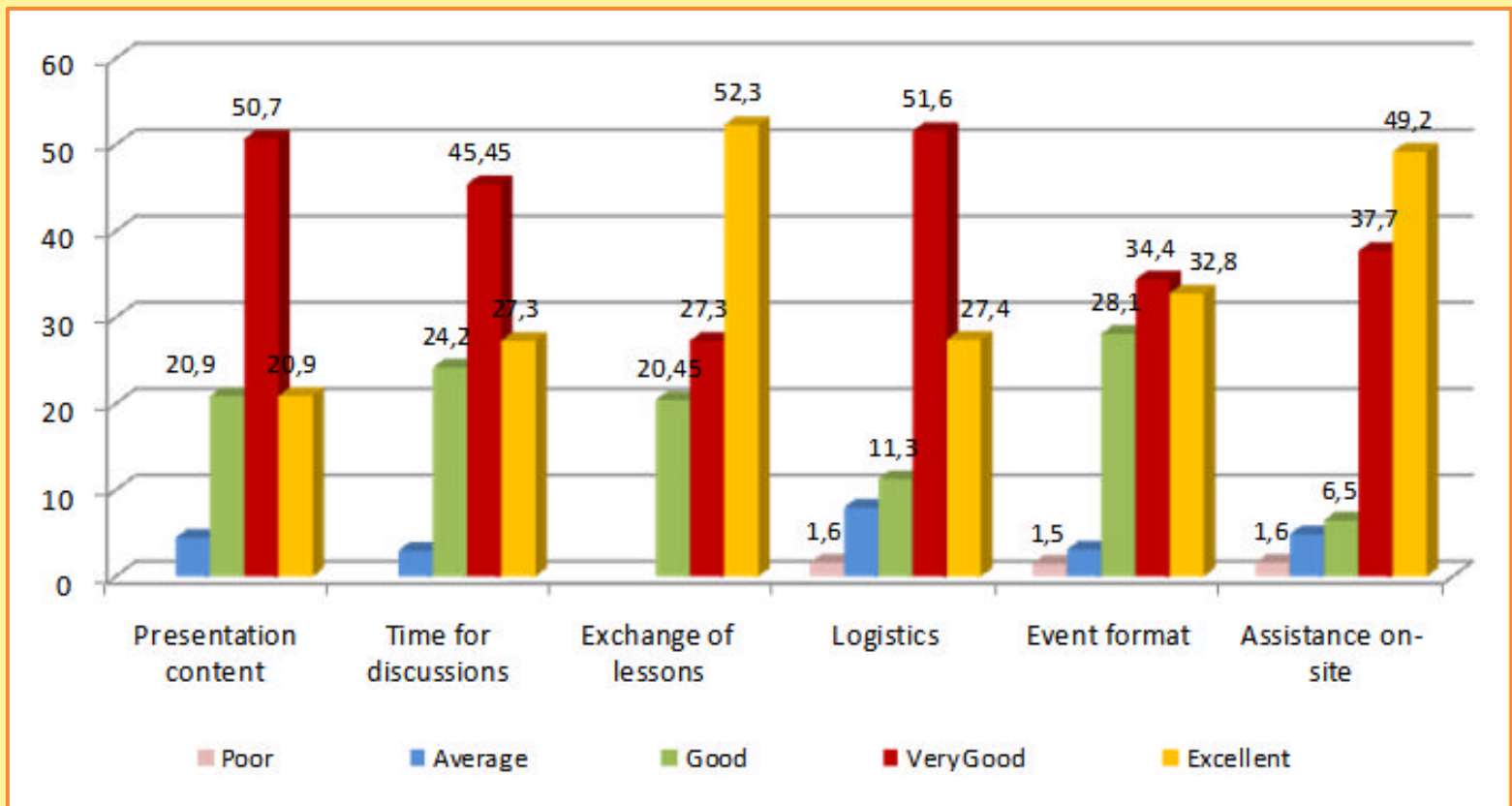

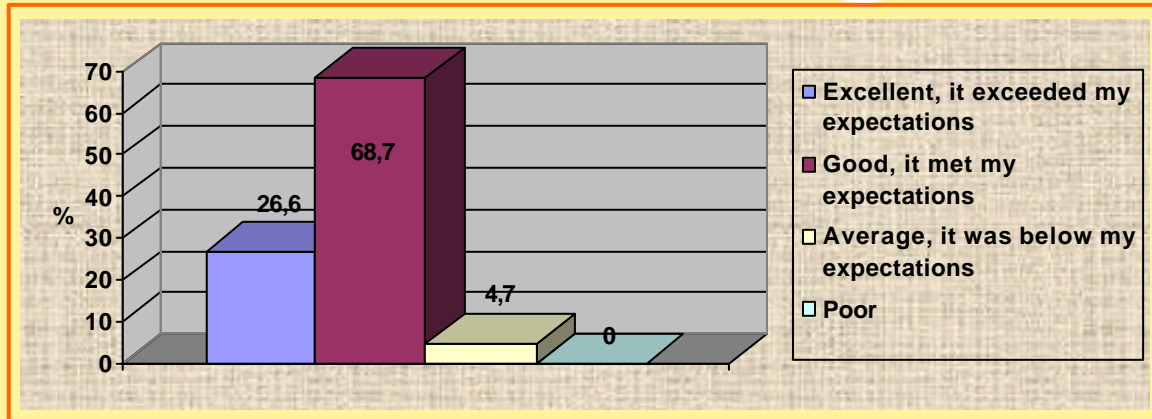
# Attendees' Satisfaction (%)

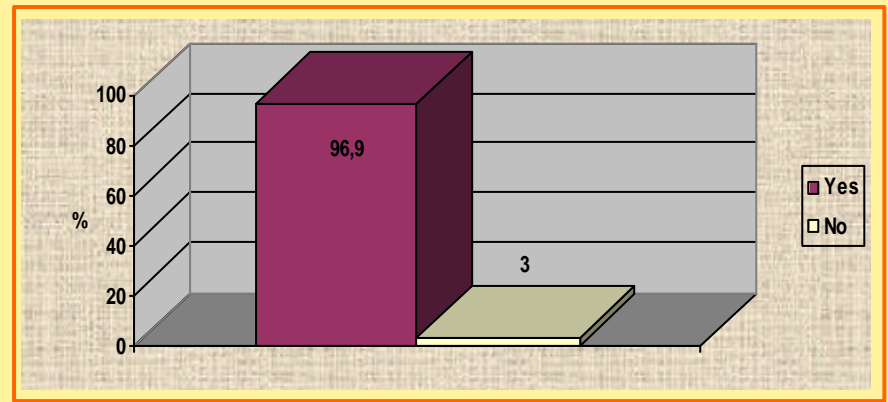

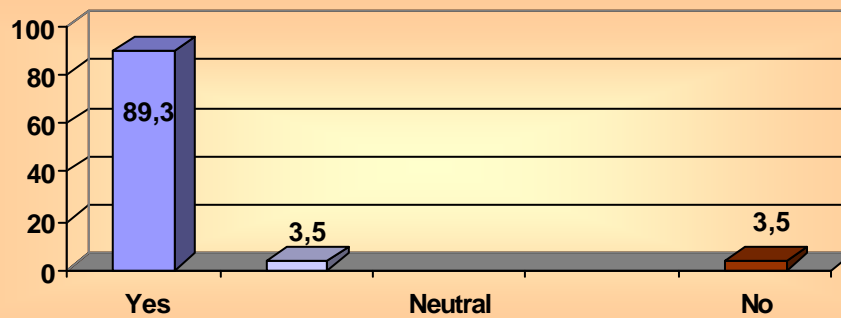
Do you think Med-e-Tel represents good value for money?



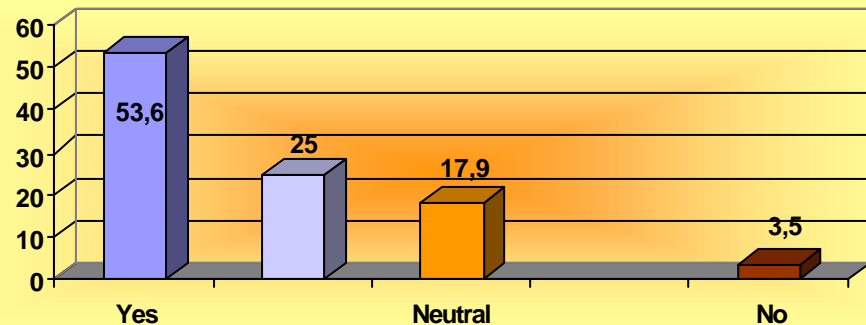
# Med-e-Tel Influencing Medical Practice

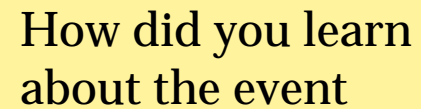
Have I learned something from this event? (%)

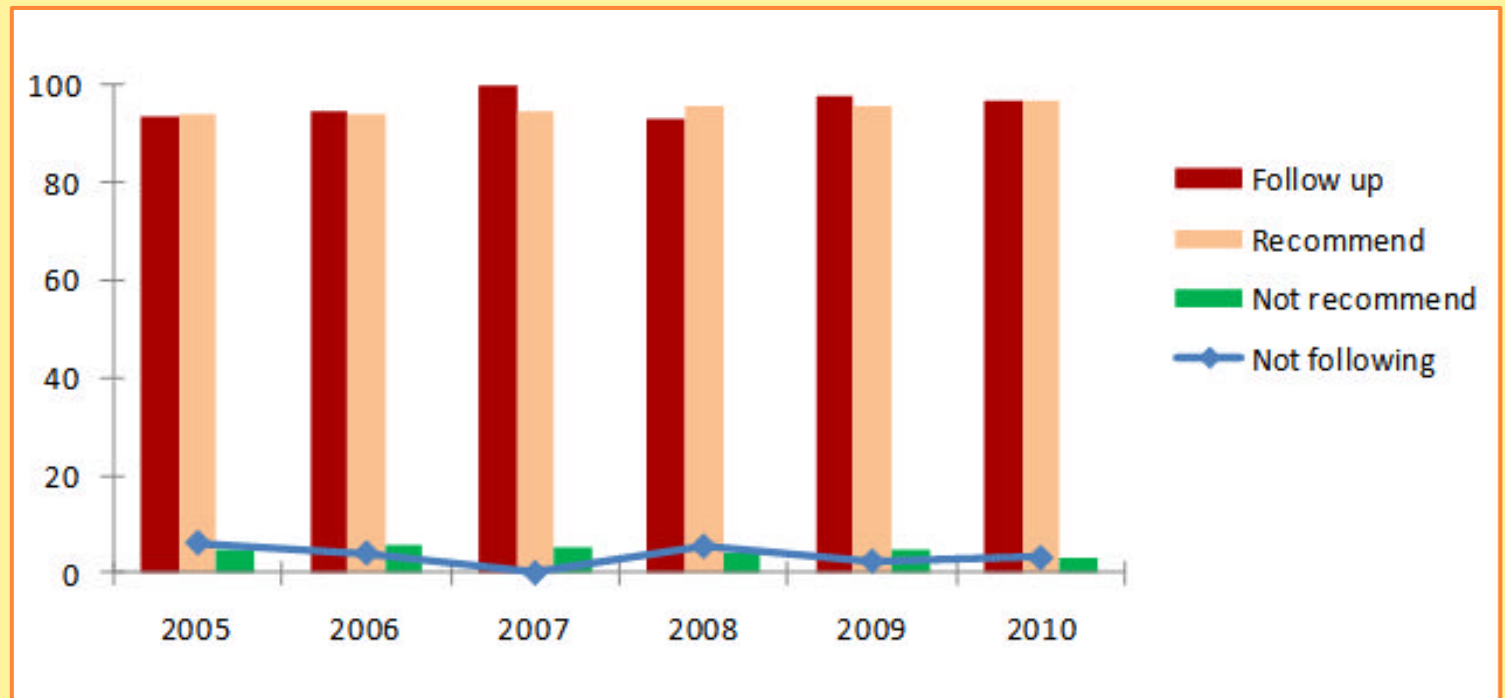
